increased adherence of antibodies to target cells, which allows for cells to be killed by the immune system

activation of complement cascade proteins by antibody bound to target cell surfaces

fragment of antibody "tail" recognized by effector cells of the immune system

different protein receptors on the cell surface that may be used as treatment targets

section of the antibody "arms" that contains the antigen-binding activity
